




Exhibition Rules

Booth Options and Rates


Fig.1 Image of Joint Exhibition Booth with basic decoration

1. Joint Exhibition Booth (Fig. 1)

- This booth plan is for a group consisting of government agencies, investment promotion agencies, and companies, from the same country or region.
- An exhibition space will be assigned to such a group on condition that a government agency or a similar organization represents the group, coordinating the members of the group, and works out its exhibition plan and also manages their exhibitions.
- Maximum size of the space per group:
(1980 mm X 1980 mm) X the number of members of the group
Booth space size will be determined by the organizer within this maximum size by taking exhibitors' request into account.
- Booth charge is free. Booth decorations other than basic decorations should be arranged at each exhibitor's responsibility and expense.

2. Standard Booth (Fig. 2)

- W 2970 mm x D 1980 mm (core dimension)
- Booth charge: 65,000 Yen / booth
(half the price of Japanese exhibitors)
- A company or organization can apply for a booth on an individual basis.
- Booth decorations other than basic decorations should be arranged at each exhibitor's responsibility and expense.
- The charge includes:
 - (a) System panels (back, sides, and a company name board)
(Side panels can be removed upon request if a booth is located at a corner or if you use multiple booths and an in-between panel is unnecessary. However, your booth charge will not be reduced.)
 - (b) 10% consumption tax

How to Apply

Please download an application form from our website, fill the necessary information and submit it to the secretariat by e-mail. In principle, we request government agencies or organizations which coordinate the group* to send us an application form, compiling the applications from the members of your group.

Remarks about Exhibition

1. Booth allocation will be determined by the organizer by taking such factors into consideration as exhibits sectors, items to be displayed, and overall floor plan.
2. Exhibitors are not allowed to transfer, lend, or exchange the assigned booths.
3. Booth height shall be lower than 2,500mm. Decoration taller than this limit must meet certain conditions. Please contact the secretariat.

Payment

1. An invoice will be mailed after receipt of application. Please remit the booth charge via bank by the date indicated by the organizer.
2. Exhibitors who need electrical work are required to pay extra charge. For more details, please check our website.

Change or Cancellation of Application

1. The number of booths cannot be changed after the application deadline.
2. In case of cancellation after the application deadline, cancellation fee will be charged. Please contact the secretariat.
3. There are no refunds for cancellation after payment.
4. Exhibition may be refused by the organizer when contents of application are judged not suitable for the exhibition objectives.

Others

1. On Security of your Booth: Please be concerned to prevent accident during the fair, including booth installation, exhibition, demonstrations, and dismantling. Although the organizer will place security staff to keep watch over the entire site, it is strongly recommended for exhibitors to insure your exhibition items by your own responsibility against theft, fire, natural disasters, and any cause beyond its control.
2. On Demonstration: Although it is allowed to perform a demonstration of your exhibition items, it may be restricted or stopped by the organizer if it is found to be causing any trouble to venue operations.
3. On Hazardous Materials: Exhibitors who plan to bring in hazardous materials defined by laws of Japan (flammable objects such as high-pressure gas or liquefied gas) to the site must submit required documents to the secretariat in advance to request permission from the fire department.
4. On Sales or Distribution of Exhibition Items: It is allowed to sell your exhibition items except for large size items that cannot be hand-carried. Distribution of catalogs, explanatory materials, product samples, promoting products, etc. are allowed only at exhibitor's booth
